He is Co-Director of the journal *Social History*, considered one of the best journals of history in this field in Spain.



He has published a chapter in the twentieth volume of the history of Spain by John Lynch about the last Socialist legislature in Spain, as well as the book *The long march towards anarchy, thought and action in the literary movement*. He is editor of UNED Intersciences collection, directed the *Dictionary of contemporary Valencian politicians* and has been responsible for editing and preliminary study of *The Jack London's iron heel*.

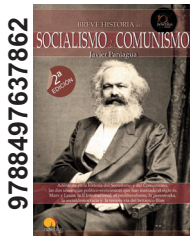
